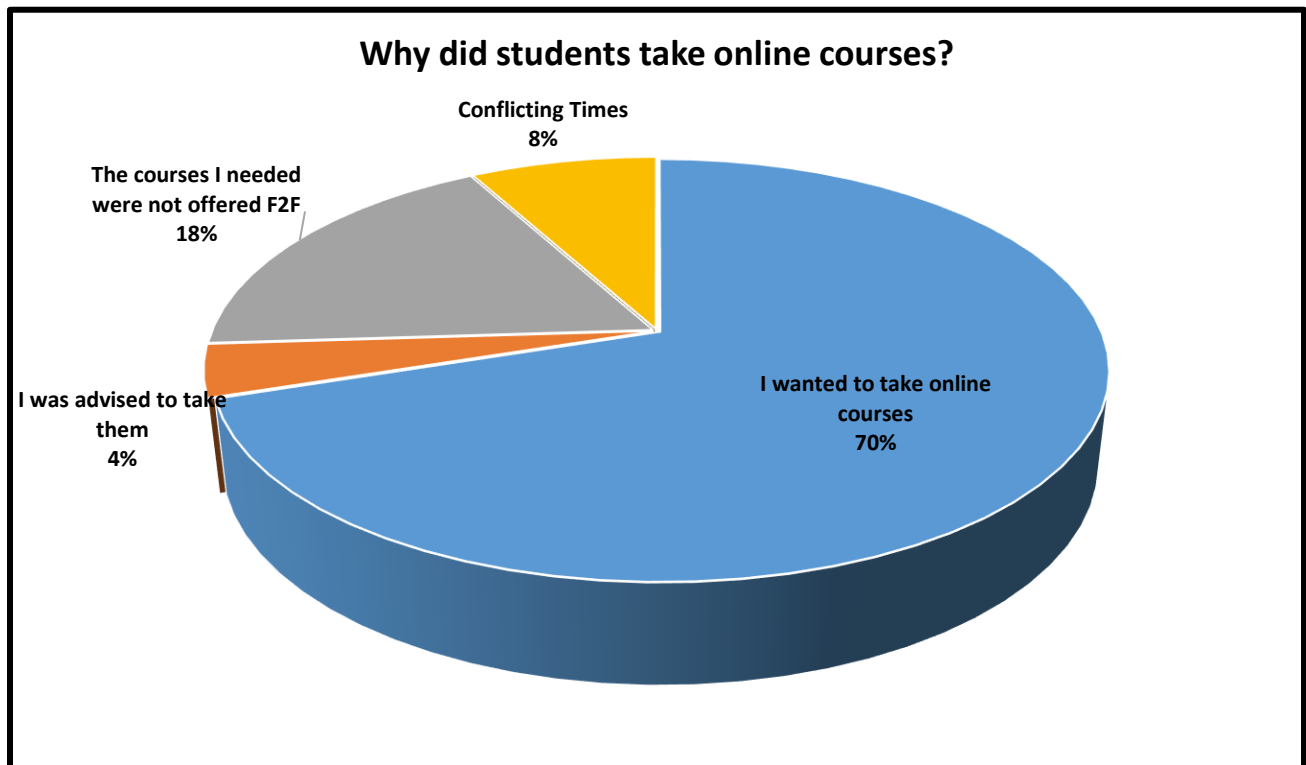


## Spring 2017 Online Student Survey Analysis

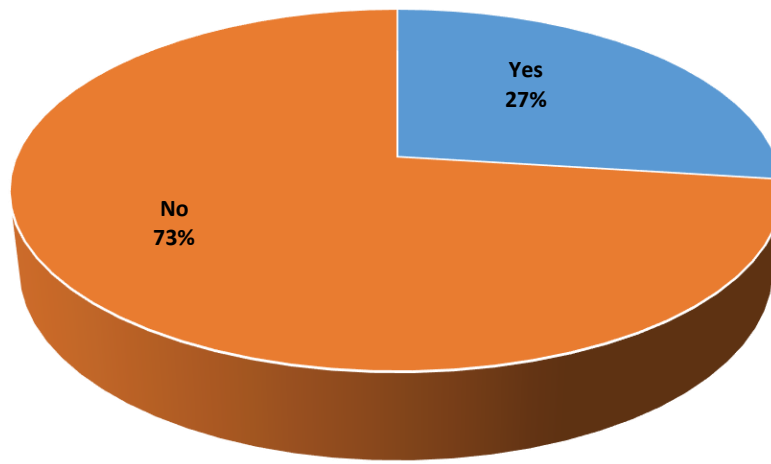
A survey was conducted during the spring 2017 semester to obtain feedback from Somerset Community College (SCC) students regarding their selection of online vs. face-to-face delivery modes and related issues with their online courses. All SCC students enrolled in an online class were invited to participate (N=3274).

Of the 674 students responding to the survey (response rate of 21%), 80% chose to participate in the survey while 20% declined participation. Of the 80% that chose to participate, 70% indicated that they wanted to take online courses, 10% said they were advised to take online courses, 18% indicated the course or courses they needed to take were not offered face-to-face, and 8% stated that the courses or courses they needed to take were offered face-to-face, but conflicted with another course they also needed. Twenty-seven percent (147; n=546) of respondents said they would have preferred to have taken a face-to-face course over an online course.



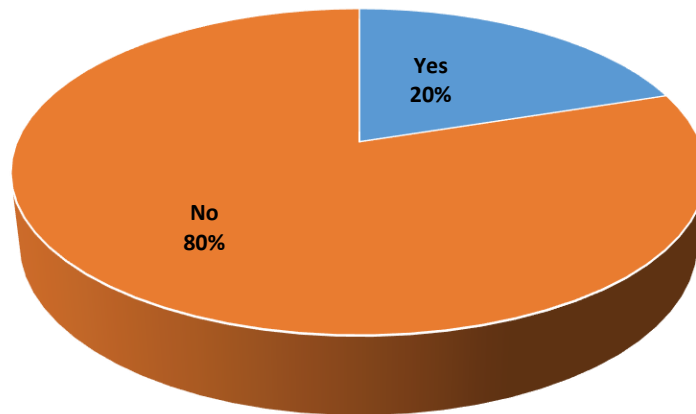
