2+2 Transfer Agreement Campbellsville University and Somerset Community College Leading to the Bachelor of Social Work Degree in Bachelor of Science Program

PURPOSE:

The framework was developed in an effort to increase the opportunities for SCC graduates to pursue baccalaureate degree programs and to enhance their ability to transfer into and complete a bachelor's degree in Social Work at Campbellsville University. This framework is consistent with the 2+2 concept and is designed to assist both institutions in meeting the CPE goals of increasing the number of baccalaureate degrees earned in the Commonwealth.

FRAMEWORK:

The framework is based upon the Associate of Arts degree as offered at SCC to complete the general education certification standards effective in the KCTCS catalog 2012-13. Upon completion of the degree and successful transfer, the student will be fully and completely accepted directly into Campbellsville University and the transfer coursework will satisfy their liberal education core. The complete transfer framework program shall consist of a minimum of 62 credit hours.

The program courses selected within this framework will fulfill all general education course categories and elective categories for the AA degree program plan. The student would have to meet the GPA requirement of 2.0, KCTCS of 24 hours/SCC of 15 hours for residency requirements, and meet the cultural studies requirement.

This transfer agreement shall be valid effective the date of execution. Both parties are in mutual understanding that the agreement can be considered null and void by either party with a written notice of 90 days being delivered to either party. Further, the agreement is continuous and should be reviewed every two academic years and approved by mutual consent and the execution of a continuance agreement.

- 47 of 120 hours required to graduate must be from a 4 year University
- 42 of 120 hours required to graduate must be 300 level or above
- 32 of 120 hours required to graduate must be from Campbellsville University to obtain Campbellsville University degree
