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THE KY FAME AMT DIFFERENCE

The Kentucky Federation for Advanced Manufacturing Education (KY FAME) is an apprentice-style training. It provides students with the needed technical skills and job experience, as well as personal behaviors and core manufacturing skills, desired by manufacturers.

The Advanced Manufacturing Technician (AMT) is a five-semester program that combines proven workplace components of apprenticeship with an earn-and-learn model. Students focus on subjects, including electricity, fluid power, mechanics, fabrication, and robotics. Students who complete this program receive the AMT Certification as well as an Associate Degree in Applied Science.

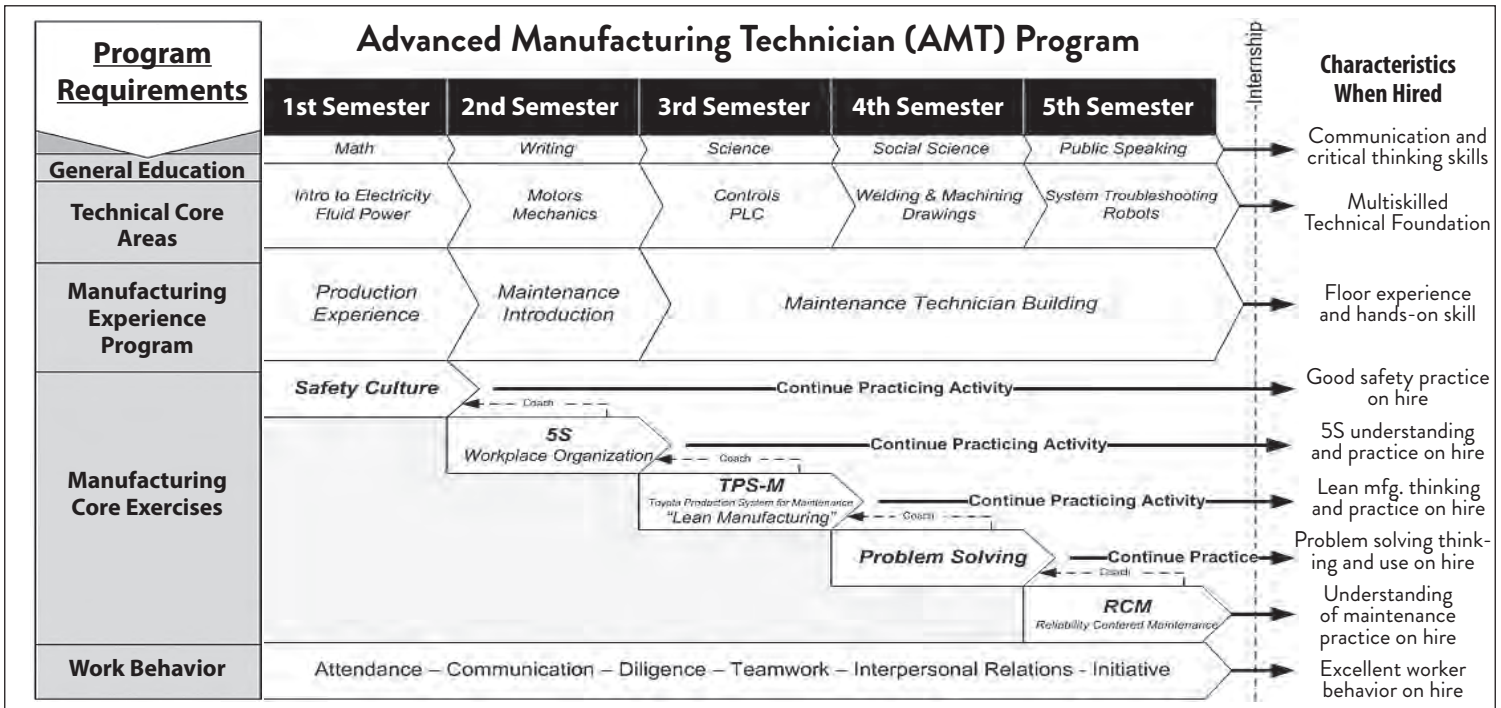

6 - STEP APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1:

To register for KY FAME, go to Somerset Community College's (SCC) website—somerset.kctcs.edu—then select ...
“**Explore All Programs/KY FAME**”.

STEP 2:

Scroll down the page and under “**How to apply for the program?**”, click the blue “**KY FAME Application**” button to complete the application.

STEP 3:

Complete all sections of the application. Questions with a red asterisk (*) must be answered. Click the blue “**Submit**” button at the bottom of the application.

STEP 4:

Complete the SCC online application at our website.

Click on the blue “**Start Your Application**” button to access the application. Select the “**Fall**” semester as the start/admit term for when you will begin your classes, and:

1. Choose the following program plan for the KY FAME Program - Plan: **MIT: Industrial Maintenance Technology**.
(Sub Plan: **Advanced Manufacturing Technician Track**.)
2. Write down your student ID. Once you have submitted your application, you will receive a student ID number to use throughout your college career.

STEP 5:

Please be sure to submit the following documents to SCC's Admissions office:

- Official high school or GED transcript
- Any official college transcripts

For information on how to submit any required documents, visit SCC's website and then select “**Admissions**”.

Click on the “**Ready? Let's Go**” blue box and select the “Information For:” area that best fits you. Then follow the directions.

STEP 6:

Request submission of your **ACT, KYOTE, Wonderlic and/or EdReady Diagnostic** test scores or schedule to test at SCC.

Please note that we cannot accept test scores that are more than 4 years old.

Additionally, if you have passed your AP test(s) you will also need to have your test score(s) submitted.
