I would like to be considered for admission into the January 2020 nursing class.

I have: (Please initial each item as you complete them)

- A current application to a KCTCS college on file. If Somerset Community College is not my current home college, I will change my home college to SCC if admitted to the program.
- I have taken the ACT or the NLN Pre-Entrance Exam. I understand that the NLN Pre-Entrance Exam can only be taken once every 12 months for application to the SCC ADN program. If this exam has been taken more than once every 12 months, the score on the first exam will be the one used in calculating points. If the NLN Pre-Entrance exam is not taken at SCC, exam results must be sent directly from NLN or you must submit an official copy of your exam results.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to confirm with the Records Office that my file includes an official high school transcript (or GED scores), official transcripts from all other colleges, universities, and/or vocational schools, if applicable. All transcripts must be sent to the Admissions Office.
- A copy of current LPN/LVN license verification from the KBN website. Students currently enrolled in a LPN program must pass the NCLEX-PN exam and submit a copy of their PN license prior to enrolling in the first nursing course, if accepted into the program
- I understand that courses in progress at the time of the application deadline will not be included when calculating points.
- I have read and understand the materials in the online nursing conference presentation before submitting this application.
- I have submitted the program application (2 pages) **and** the statement of program requirements

Documents may be turned in to the Nursing Coordinator or Division Assistant from May 20, 2019 through June 1, 2019 at 4:30 p.m.(EST). If you mail your letter of intent, please call the Nursing Coordinator, before the deadline, to make sure your materials were received. Statement of Program Requirements (2018-2020)

\_\_\_\_\_ I have read and understand the information in the online nursing conference presentation. Questions can be directed to the Nursing Coordinator at (606) 451-6737 or linda.ballard@kctcs.edu.

\_\_\_\_\_ I have read the technical standards associated with the nursing program.

\_\_\_\_\_ I have been informed that the KBN has the power to deny admission to the licensure examination for a person convicted of a felony or misdemeanor. In part the law states, "The board shall have power to deny, limit, revoke, or suspend any license to practice nursing issued by the board or applied for, or to deny admission to the licensure exam upon proof that the person: has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor involving drugs, alcohol, fraud, deceit, falsification of records, a breach of trust, physical harm or endangerment to others, or dishonesty. Applicants to the licensure exam must report all criminal convictions to KBN.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that clinical facilities require a criminal background check and a drug screen before being allowed to participate in clinical experiences. I also understand that the ADN program requires me to have a criminal background check and a drug screen once a year before participating in clinical experiences. If I do not "pass" the test, the facility may refuse to allow you to practice in their facility and may be dismissed from the program. The cost of these checks/screens will be my responsibility.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that ADN program classes and clinical schedules are non-negotiable and will vary each semester.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that all visible tattoos and body piercings (except earrings) must be covered before entering the clinical site.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if admitted to the program, I must submit proof of certain immunizations, documentation of yearly TB skin tests, and maintain CPR certification. Students must begin the series of Hepatitis B vaccinations or sign a Hepatitis B declination form before beginning clinical. I must also purchase liability insurance, as provided through KCTCS, at the beginning of each semester. I may also be required to complete an orientation to each clinical facility.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that there are mandatory purchases for the program including, but not limited to, textbooks, uniforms, shoes, and laboratory kits.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that it is my responsibility to turn in all required application materials by the appropriate deadline date. Application deadline date for the Evening/Weekend program is June 1, 2019 (materials can be turned in from May 20 through June 1, 2019). If the deadline falls on a weekend, holiday, or a day the college is closed, the deadline will be extended to the next business day. Applications turned in at times other than those previously listed, may be returned.
