#### **PROGRAM DETAILS**

Course work in this program is presented in an evening/weekend format for working students. The Associate Degree Nursing program prepares graduates to use their skill and knowledge to fulfill the role of the nurse: enhance human flourishing, demonstrate sound nursing judgment, continually develop professional identity, and possess a spirit of inquiry to improve

the quality of patient care. Encompassed within these roles are the core components of context and environment, knowledge and science, personal/ professional development, quality and safety, relationshipcentered care, and teamwork. These core components are introduced, developed and built upon through the curriculum. Graduates are eligible to take the National

Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). The Associate Degree Nursing curriculum is organized around a clearly defined conceptual framework and combines general education and nursing courses. The nursing courses correlate classroom and clinical instruction in a variety of community agencies.

Program admits once every three semesters. Call the nursing office for dates.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

The following materials must be submitted to the Admissions/Records office by the deadline date. (Call nursing office for dates):

- Application for admission to a KCTCS college.
- Official high school transcript indicating that the applicant has or will complete a high school course of study or a passing GED official score report.
- Transcripts of all post-secondary work completed at other institutions.
- Results of the ACT or PAX-RN (NLN Pre-Entrance Exam).
- Read the online pre-admission conference presentation and print, complete, and submit the Program Application and the Statement of Program Requirements by the appropriate deadline. The conference presentation can be found at: http://somerset.kctcs.edu/Academics/Programs\_of\_ Study/Health\_-\_Associate\_Degree\_Nursing\_Eve\_ Weekend.aspx.
- A copy of current LPN/LVN license verification from the KBN website. Students currently enrolled in an LPN program must pass the NCLEX-PN exam and submit a copy of their PN license prior to enrolling in the first nursing course, if accepted into the program.
- Evidence of holding an active unrestricted license for practical/vocational nursing prior to enrolling in Nursing 197. LPN's who graduated more than 3 years prior to admission into the ADN program must provide verification of current employment. Current employment shall be defined as 1 year full-time employment as a LPN/LVN within the last 3 years. Employment in nursing shall be defined as patient/client contact and shall be verified by the employing agency/agencies using the verification of employment form.

Upon admission to the program, the student must submit the following:

- Evidence of receiving the Hepatitis B vaccine series or a vaccine declination form
- TB skin test or chest x-ray
- · Immunization records
- Other vaccinations may be required depending upon clinical facility
- Current CPR certification
   (American Heart Association)
- (American Heart Association BLS Health Care Providers)
- Criminal background check and drug screen once a year
