Statement of Program Requirements

This statement of program requirements must be signed, dated, and submitted at the time of application to the program.

I have read the technical standards associated with the nursing program.

I have been informed that the KBN has the power to deny admission to the licensure examination for a person convicted of a felony or misdemeanor. In part the law states, "The board shall have power to deny, limit, revoke, or suspend any license to practice nursing issued by the board or applied for, or to deny admission to the licensure exam upon proof that the person: has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor involving drugs, alcohol, fraud, deceit, falsification of records, a breach of trust, physical harm or endangerment to others, or dishonesty. Applicants to the licensure exam must report all criminal convictions to KBN.

Clinical facilities require a criminal background check and a drug screen before students are allowed to participate in clinical experiences. The ADN program requires students to have a criminal background check and a drug screen once a year before participation in clinical experiences. If you do not "pass" the test, the facility may refuse to allow you to practice in their facility. The cost of these checks/screens will be the responsibility of the student.

ADN program classes and clinical schedules are non-negotiable and will vary each semester.

All visible tattoos and body piercings (except earrings) must be covered before a student enters the clinical site.

If admitted to the program, students must submit proof of certain immunizations, documentation of yearly TB skin tests, and maintain CPR certification. Students must begin the series of Hepatitis B vaccinations or sign a Hepatitis B declination form before beginning clinical. Students must also purchase liability insurance, as provided through KCTCS, at the beginning of each semester. Students will also be required to complete an orientation to each clinical facility.

There are mandatory purchases for the program including, but not limited to, textbooks, uniforms, shoes, and laboratory kits.

I understand that it is my responsibility to turn in all required application materials by the appropriate deadline date. Application deadline date for the Somerset campus program is March 1 (materials can be turned in from February 15 through March 1, 2018). The application deadline date for the Laurel campus program is July 1 (materials can be turned in from June 18 through July 2). If the deadline falls on a weekend, holiday, or a day the college is closed, the deadline will be extended to the next business day.
